A PGL Animateur will lead each session. Please ensure there is at least one supervising adult from your group present to support your evening entertainment programme. All activities are suitable for large or small groups and will incorporate a French element such as introductions using basic French vocabulary. The core delivery will be in English.

We are very happy to welcome additional adults to join in with the evening entertainment and any assistance with tasks such as judging, keeping score, assisting individual groups etc. will be very gratefully received.

Entertainment suitable for all age groups:

Soirée Crêpes (Crepe Making)

The group is split into teams and given an introductory presentation with a brief history of crêpes. French language is used in the presentation, encouraging guests to use French when naming ingredients. Each team then makes their own crêpe batter and cooks their crêpes before tucking in!
